



Graywater FAQ

- A graywater system will not affect your water pressure
- You can irrigate fruit trees, ornamental trees, groundcover and lawns with graywater
- Do NOT irrigate root or leafy vegetables or other food crops that touch the soil with graywater, for health and safety reasons
- Graywater is alkaline due to the basic nature of soaps and cleaning chemicals mixed in with the water. Choose plants that like alkaline soil
- Permits are NOT required for certain systems in one- and two-family dwellings
- Permits are required for multi-family dwellings
